Program includes OSF tickets to *A Midsummer Night's dream* by William Shakespeare, *A View from the Bridge* by Arthur Miller and *The Further Adventures of Hedda Gabler* by Jeff Whitty.

Program cost of \$845 (double occupancy) includes all classes, lodging (deluxe room with private bath on campus), all meals with the exception of one dinner "on your own" to explore one of Ashland's many fine restaurants, theatre tickets and van shuttle to the theatre for all scheduled performances. No add-on fees or gratuities of any kind!

Single occupancy rooms are available for an additional \$180. Or, if you'd like to save money, request a standard shared-bath guest room in the same residence on campus and pay only \$725. Single occupancy shared-bath room is available for \$805. Be sure to note which type of room you would like when registering.
